Dear Property Owner,

The Davidson Historic District is being nominated for listing on the National Register for Historic Places and a public information session will be held on Thursday, January 29 at 7:00 p.m. in Eumenean Hall on the Davidson College campus. We encourage all property owners within the proposed district boundary to attend. The information session is being hosted by the Town of Davidson Planning Department and the North Carolina State Historic Preservation Office (NC SHPO). We will answer your questions regarding the National Register and incentives for affected property owners at the information session.

It is an honor to be listed on the National Register and generally does not carry any regulations for property owners. However, property owners in the District would be eligible for tax credits of approved repair and construction projects. Eumenean Hall is located on the east side of North Main Street (NC 115) on the Davidson College campus near the intersection with Depot Street.
