Husemann submits resignation; Board appoints Interim Town Manager

MOORESVILLE, N.C. - The Town of Mooresville Board of Commissioners accepted the resignation of Town Manager Steve Husemann, effective at midnight, January 9, 2011, and appointed Assistant Town Manager Erskine Smith to serve as Interim Town Manager.

"It was with great expectation that Mr. Husemann came to the Town as a qualified and experienced manager," said Commissioner Mitch Abraham in a statement during Monday's meeting. "Mr. Husemann has served the town well and his professionalism and personal integrity are unquestioned. However, the Board has decided to take a different direction for the future of the town. This is not a reflection on Mr. Husemann's abilities, but instead a difference in philosophies."

At their meeting Monday night, commissioners voted unanimously to appoint Smith, a veteran employee who has worked for the town for 23 years, to serve as Interim Town Manager effective on January 10, 2011. "Moving forward, Smith's appointment to the position of interim is a very positive step towards achieving the goals of the Board and the Town. We look forward to his leadership moving forward and to him building a team to implement our vision for the future," said commissioners.

"I am glad to have this opportunity to serve Mooresville in this capacity and welcome the opportunity to move Mooresville forward into the future," said Smith.

Commissioner Mac Herring said, "The Board of Commissioners wants to thank Mr. Husemann for his two plus years of dedication and service to the Town of Mooresville staff and its citizens. We wish Mr. Husemann and his wife, Diana, the best in the future." Commissioner Thurman Houston added, "Erskine has a great deal of knowledge about the Town and its employees, I believe he can and will serve this community well."
